- 1 Teacher/Coach per team may complete a 'Grassroots Coaching Course' to be conducted at a location within a local district FREE OF CHARGE upon registering (VALUE \$25)

Country Districts: For this first year we will just be offering carnivals in metropolitan areas. Schools in Country Districts wishing to be involved should contact Jonathan Ruse at the FFSA if they wish to join one of the Metropolitan carnivals.

Game Lengths: 20 Minutes

Format: All Carnivals will run from 9:30am – 2:30pm. A short briefing will occur at 9:15am

Lunch Break: Each team will have a 30 – 40 minute lunch break

Age Categories: Year 4/5 Girls, Year 6/7 Girls

Cost: \$25 per team

Transport: Your school will be responsible for your team(s) travel to and from the Carnival.
